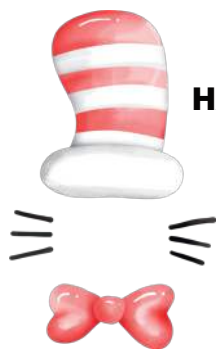

Did pop can returns build up over Christmas Break? We are always taking can donations in the front lobby. These funds go to PTL and help support many school activities. Thank you!

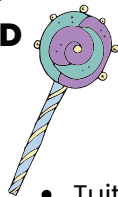
