- *clothing (a spare set) – to be kept @ school in locker
- *crayons (24 pack) – Crayola brand are more durable and last longer ☺
- *Composition book wide-ruled (2)
- *dry erase board (1 standard size)
- *dry erase Expo colored markers (1 pack of 4 wide tip, 1 pack of 4 fine tip)
- *glue (pack of 4 sticks, 1 bottle of liquid)
- *gym shoes to leave in locker (a pair they can tie/Velcro on own)
- *hand soap – (1 bottle...kills 99.9% of germs)
- *headphones for Kdg. (1st grade ones are stored in classroom from last year)
- *index cards – 1 pack
- *lunch bag or box
- *markers (1 pack wide tip, 1 pack fine tip) – washable preferred

- *water bottle – no glass please and an easy, accessible lid for our young ones
