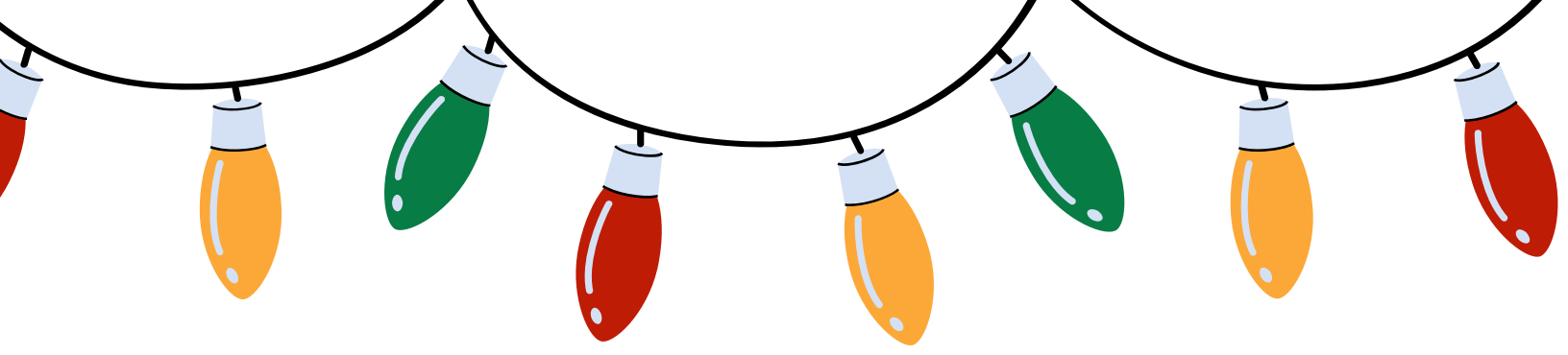

I look forward to seeing you all before the Holiday Season begins. Please email me with any questions you may have.

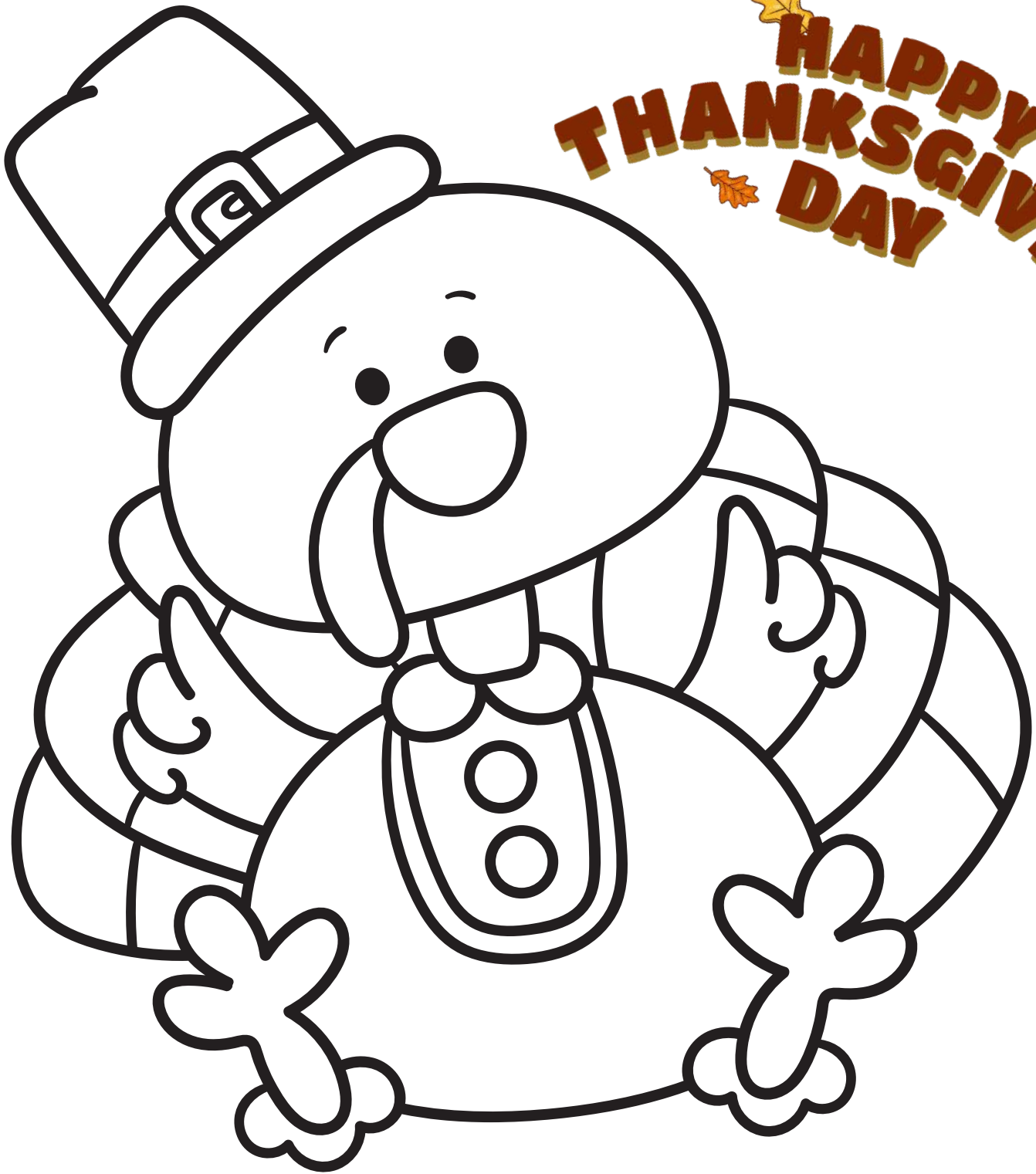
